Experience and Forgiveness

My name is Leslie I'm 45 years old . I've struggled with addiction to drugs and alcohol in the past 30 years. I grew up in a great family, but my mom introduced me to drugs in grade school. By the time I shared this with anyone, I was addicted and that addiction continued for the next 30 years.

I lost my mom in 1996 from drugs, and I lost a brother to leukemia in 2009. I hit rock bottom after he passed away. I had a blocked intestine in June of 2015, almost dying, which led me to realize I needed help. I found out about Teen Challenge and came shortly after.

Since being at Grace House, I realized that God never left me, even when I turned my back on Him. I grew up in a Lutheran school but grew distant from God. Now, I realize so many times He was there for me. Through animals and nature, He showed Himself again and again! It's wonderful to know He's never left me.

I now experience God's love and feel His peace. I have forgiven myself and others. I've had so many things broken off of me, including my addiction. I know I'm forgiven and God loves me and has a purpose and a plan for me. I'm excited to venture forward and see what He has in store for me in the future. The verse I stand on is John 10:10, "The devil comes to steal, kill and destroy, but I came to give you life full of joy, overflowing to the fullest."



THOUGH I FALL, I WILL RISE

My name is Danial. When I was born, my birth mother left me at the hospital. Now looking back, I know God had a plan for me and had His hand on me right from the start. I was born in Bucharest, Romania and I lived in an orphan home for 3 years. A loving American military family found my picture in the Bethany Christian adoption agency, and decided they would like me to be a part of their family. A few years down the road, I was diagnosed with reactive attachment disorder. I thought I had to do things to receive love from my family; and I had trust issues to where I never knew if someone was going to abandon me like my birth mother did.

I began to mask this pain with alcohol at age 11, before

turning to pills and marijuana. By the age of 13, I found myself at Fairbanks rehab treatment facility. I wrestled all throughout high school, wrestled in college and went over to Russia to train and compete, but eventually my addiction caught up with me where I ended up dropping out of college and caught 14 charges in a matter of 8 month. I was looking at some serious time in prison, but God had a plan for me. He opened a door so I could come to Teen Challenge and get my life together. God did this so I could fulfill the plan He had formed from the start, that the enemy tried to ruin.

Since coming to Wabash Valley Teen Challenge, I have given my life to God and let Him show me how good He is. God has restored my relationship with my family. He has broken the adoption spirit over my life and taken away the burden of reactive attachment disorder. God has been so good to me, and I gave him my life because Jesus died so I may live and have eternal life.

Since being here, I wouldn't trade it for anything in the world. I have witnessed miracles, broken families restored, the blind receiving their sight. The Bible verse I stand on is "Do not gloat over me, my enemies! For though I fall, I will rise again. Though I sit in darkness, the Lord will be my light." Micah 7:8 (NLT)
